

Snowmobile Trips

Feb. 4 - 5 & Mar. 3 - 4 (Sat-Sun): Couples "Getaway"

"Half Day" Snowmobile Tour, Hot Springs, Monarch Ski Weekend Saturday meet at ORC at 8:30 a.m., load up the gear and supplies and head to Buena Vista. After we check into our hotel we'll head over to monarch tours, sign-in and suit-up it's off to the start of the adventure; high-speed straight-a-ways, bowls and tight twisty single-track runs through the trees await you! You'll get to drive a snowmobile through the back-country for half a day! After an incredible snowmobile adventure, we'll soak our bones at Mt. Princeton Hot Springs. After a soak (or maybe before, depending on time), we'll get some chow in town and then crash out for the night in Salida. On Sunday morning we're off to Monarch Mountain for some downhill ski and snowboarding.

Cost: \$660 per couple if you each want your own sled and \$585 per couple if you both share a sled. Activity includes: Transportation, guides, half-day snowmobile trip, lodging, hot springs entry, Monarch lift tickets, warm clothing boots and helmet for snowmobiling Snowmobile insurance (still have a \$250 deductible). Rent skis or snowboard equipment for this activity from Outdoor Rec. for half price and save more money!. Group size is limited to 5 couples max, so sign up early!

Leaving Outdoor Rec. at 4 p.m. Friday you and your sweetheart will head out for a romantic ski weekend at one of Colorado's most beautiful resorts, Winter Park. Winter Park has more than 20 lifts, miles upon miles of ski and snowboard trails and breathtaking views. You will be dropped off at "The Vintage Hotel" just 1/3 a mile from the slopes. Don't worry the Cabriolet (Ariel transport) will take you right to the slopes in the morning. The hotel has a fitness center Dry Sauna oversized hot tub and an onsite restaurant. Don't want to ski both days? Maybe you would like to take your valentine tubing, dog sledding, snowshoeing or even snowmobiling instead. Sunday check out of your room by 10 a.m., leave your stuff at the hotel and go enjoy another full day of activities before your transportation arrives at 4 p.m. to bring you home. Moab Utah Mountain Biking Trip

We're going to Moab! We rented cabins at the Moab Valley RV resort. Cabins are in a secured gated area with laundry facilities, bike wash area, BBQ, cable T.V. mini frig, playground, hot tub and yes, a swimming pool! You can see the cabins at: <http://www.moabvalleyrv.com/>. OAP will offer activities that best fit the group's wishes and individuals abilities. We may split the guides and offer an easy ride and a harder ride as well, or even a sightseeing hike. If you want to take off and do your own thing like a jeep tour or rent ATV's feel free, you can just take advantage of the cheap transportation and lodging and do your own thing if you wish. The OAP schedule is as follows: Friday, March 16 everyone meets at Outdoor Rec. 8 am to load and go. Moab arrival time around 5 pm, unpack; go into town for shopping and food. Saturday we'll go to Gemini Bridges; these twin natural bridges span hundreds of feet over the valley below. After you explore the bridges continue biking down to the shuttle or back to town if you want. This is a great ride to "check your skills" and for the guides to plan activities to accommodate your abilities. The rest of the trip will be made up as we go to assure everyone has the best trip possible. Other activities will include an easier bike ride and a more challenging bike ride offered each day, as well as a full day going into Arches National Park. We'll enjoy some short hikes and view some petroglyphs, pictographs and dinosaur foot prints. We'll even hike and or bike the world famous "Slick Rock" bike trial at night. We may even be able to throw in a 75' rappel for those who are daring.

To keep these prices this low a minimum of 9 participants is needed. Space is limited! Empty cabins will be cancelled on Feb. 15 ; space may still be available in partially filled cabins. Five lodging arrangements available, sign-up early and save. Option: Cabins include: 1 queen, 1 Double, 1 bunk bed small refrigerator, air conditioner and heat, bedding, and cable TV Single Person Sign up in Cabin (grouped with others) =\$275 ea Two people "only" in a cabin =\$575 total Three People "only" in a cabin in a cabin=\$675 total Four People in a cabin pay only \$775 total (add up to 2 more in this room for only \$60 ea)

Ski and Snowboard Trips

Leave the driving to us! Experience some of Colorado's finest skiing. Meet at ORC at 5:45 a.m. to load up. Arrival times at resorts will vary depending on traffic, distance and weather conditions. Enjoy a full day on the slopes, then load up at 4 p.m. and enjoy the scenery, read a book, or recover with a nap, while ORC gets you back safe and sound. Return times will also vary. Activity fee is \$29. Lift tickets must be purchased separately. Full payment reservations are required. Minimum age is 18, unless accompanied by an adult. Don't want to deal with equipment? Rent your gear (additional charge from trip fee) and we will store it, load it, and then return it for you. No more taking gear home, then back to ORC, then back home, and then back to ORC again! Only for participant on OAP activities. Please Sign up no later than three days prior to activity. A minimum number of participants are required.
