

RENTAL POLICIES

- Must be 18 years of age with valid ID.
- Reservations may be made up to three days in advance.
- Current ski season equipment fittings must be on file in order to reserve equipment.
- Reserved equipment that is not picked up or cancelled prior to the date of pickup will be charged a set up fee.
- Equipment that is returned dirty will be charged a cleaning fee.
- Equipment that is returned damaged will be charged a damage or replacement fee.
- Equipment that is returned late will be charged a late fee.

SELECTING YOUR SKIER TYPE

Your skier type, weight, age and boot sole length are used by the shop technician to determine the release/retention settings of your ski bindings. It is important to provide accurate information. Inaccurate information may increase your risk of injury. Consult the following descriptions to select your Skier Type:

TYPE I Ski Cautiously

- Prefer slower speeds
- Prefer cautious skiing on smooth slopes of gentle to moderate pitch
- Favor lower than average release/retention settings
- Prefer an increased risk of inadvertent binding release in order to gain release ability in a fall

TYPE II Ski Moderately

- Prefer a variety of speeds
- Prefer to ski on varied terrain
- Skiers not classified as Type I or Type III
- Favor average release/retention setting appropriate for more recreational skiing

TYPE III Aggressively

- Normally ski at faster rate
- Prefer fast and aggressive skiing on slopes of moderate to steep pitch
- Prefer higher than average release/retention settings
- Prefer decreased release ability in a fall in order to gain a decreased risk of inadvertent binding release
