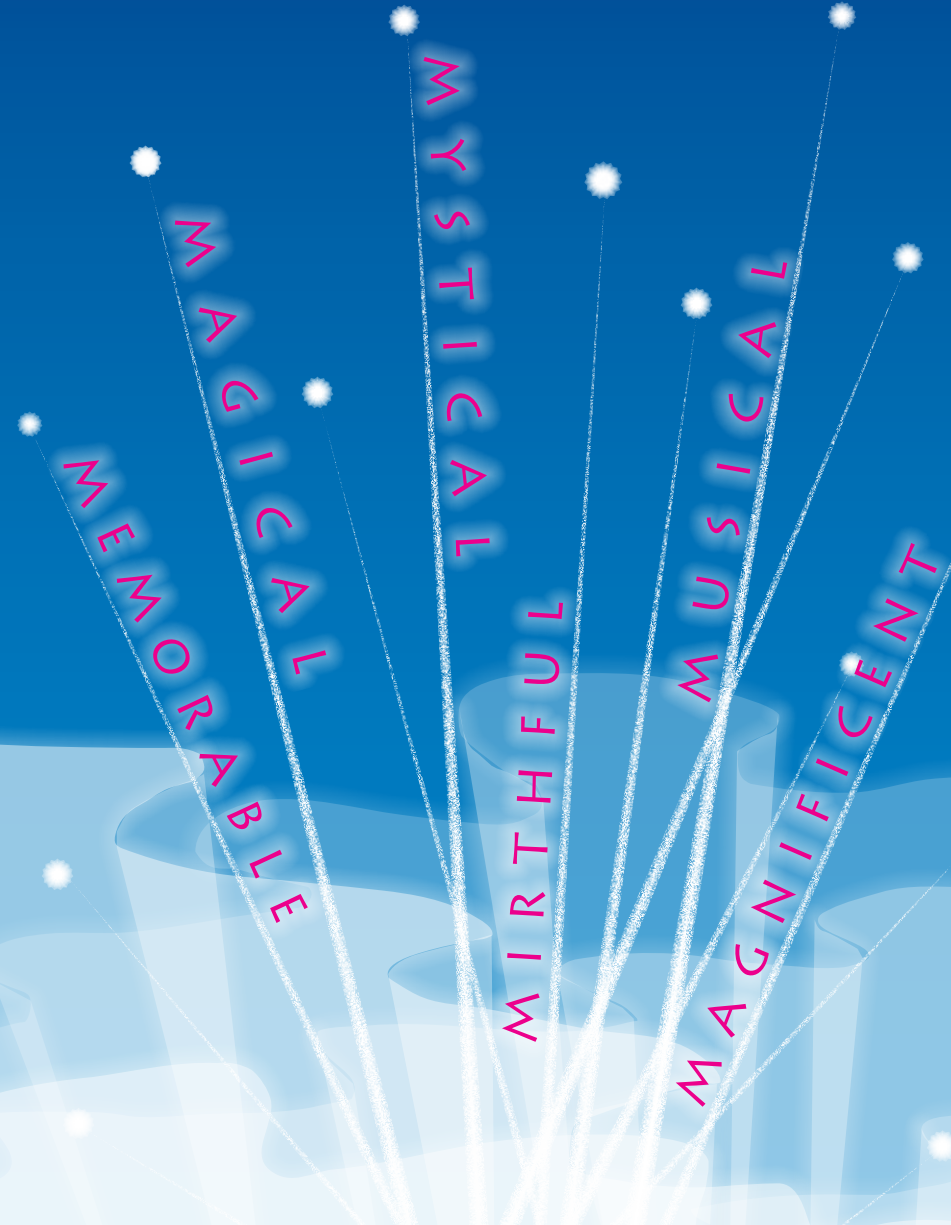

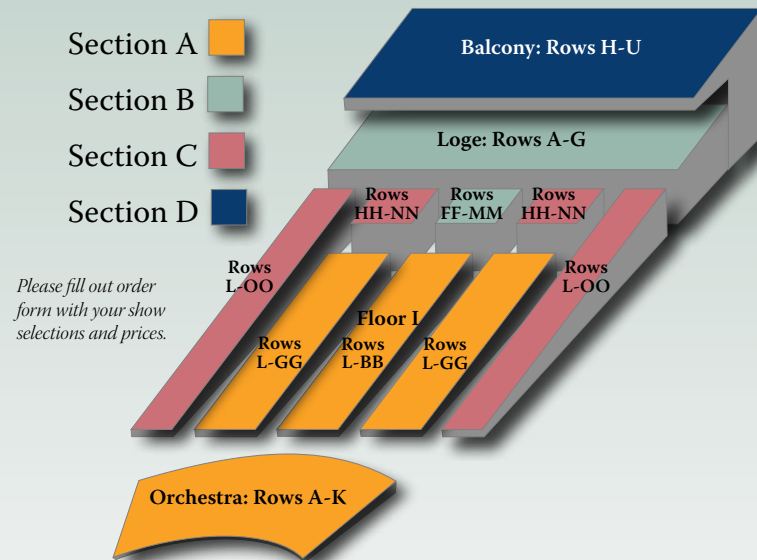

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

REFUNDS/EXCHANGES

All sales are final. Only season subscribers may exchange tickets for another performance during the season. Exchanges must be made in person at the Box Office 10 business days prior to the date shown on the original tickets. An exchange fee of \$3 per ticket will be applied. All exchanges are subject to availability. No refunds will be made for differences in ticket price, and an increase in ticket price may apply if upgrading. Missed performances will not be refunded. Attempt to sell your tickets to a friend or a family member.

PAYMENT

Payment can be made with MasterCard or VISA for Academy Concert performances. Personal checks are accepted and should be made payable to Academy Concerts. Single ticket orders will be filled after subscription orders are completed. Orders will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Unless the performance is cancelled, no refunds are given for any reason.

Academy Concerts seeks to provide a diverse range of artistic expression. While most performances are suitable for the entire family, some programs may contain adult subject material. Remember every patron, regardless of age must have a ticket. The only exception are children 2 years and younger who sit on their parent's lap. Children who cause disruption or who are unable to sit quietly may be asked to leave.

LATE SEATING

Doors open one half hour before each performance. Latecomers will be seated at the discretion of the House Manager according to the wishes of the artist.

PERFORMANCE POLICY

Programs, artists and performance dates are subject to change without notice. Should circumstances prevent an attraction from appearing as announced, a replacement performance (which may be at a different date and time) will try to be rescheduled for subscribers. If a replacement is not possible a refund will be made for that show. In the event of adverse weather and/or less than ideal road conditions, the performance will go on as scheduled if the artist or attraction is present (no refunds, credits or exchanges will be offered). In the event of an unavoidable change in venue, seating will be assigned to comparable locations for shows at all venues.

ACADEMY CONCERTS REQUESTS

Please plan to take your seats at least 15 minutes prior to the performance. Cameras, video cameras and sound recording devices are prohibited. Please turn off all phones, pagers and watches and refrain from unwrapping candies during the performance (Food and beverages are not permitted in the theater). Dennis Miller - In Concert

The Emmy award winning host of CNBC's "DENNIS MILLER", a topical interview talk show featuring reasoned discourse opinion and humor, will open the Academy Concerts 2009 season in Arnold Hall Theater.

It's been said that DENNIS MILLER is "One of the Premiere comedy talents in America today..." He is an American standup comedian, political commentator, sports commentator, and television/radio personality. Miller is known for his laid-back style and brooding sense of humor. His specialty is the "rant" – a stream-of-consciousness tirade monologue in which he rails against whatever happens to be bothering him at the moment.

He rose to fame as the Weekend Update Anchor on Saturday Night Live for six years and then went on to host his own talk shows on HBO, CNBC, and in syndication. He is a five-time Emmy Award winner for his critically acclaimed half-hour, live talk show "DENNIS MILLER Live" which had a nine year run on HBO. For two seasons, Miller called the plays alongside Al Michaels and NFL Hall of Fame quarterback Dan Fouts on ABC's "Monday Night Football." He wrote and starred in the Emmy-nominated cable comedy special, "The Raw Feed", his sixth such special.

He has also been cast in films, usually in dramatic roles, most notably in 1994's "Disclosure," 1995's "The Net," and 1996's "Murder at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue".

He currently hosts a daily three-hour self-titled talk radio program.

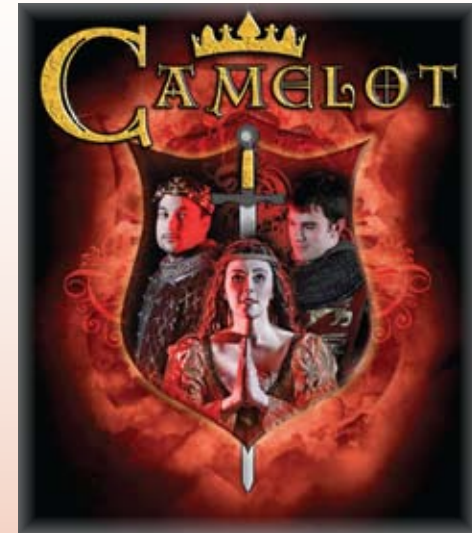
