As the only original Robert Trent Jones Sr. design in Colorado, the Blue course stands alone. The fairways wind their way through majestic ponderosa pines and offer stunning views of the Rocky Mountains.

The Blue course has played host to a number of prestigious tournaments over the years, including Shells Wonderful World of Golf featuring Sam Snead and Jimmy Demeret, the 1991 Cannon Cup with an all -star field of future tour players, headed by a young Tiger Woods, the annual Gene Miranda Falcon Invitational Division 1 college tournament to name just a few.

Stretching over 7500 yards in length, this one of a kind gem will challenge the best golfers in the world but can accommodate golfers of all levels.

The courses at Eisenhower are situated in the middle of the world famous United States Air Force Academy where every year up to a thousand young men and women graduate to become officers in the United States Air Force.

Previously voted by Golf and Leisure magazine as the number one ranked military course in the world the Blue course has appeared in golf digest's list of top 100 courses in the United States.
