CRESTED BUTTE

CRESTED BUTTE MOUNTAIN RESORT

Fri., Jan. 25, noon - Sun., Jan. 27, 9 p.m.

THE RESORT

Explore 1,547 acres of in-bound terrain accessed by 15 chairlifts. This resort is ideal for families with 26% beginner, 57% intermediate, 14% advance and 3% expert terrain. With a base of 9,375 feet and a summit of 12,162 ft and two terrain parks, The Gold Link and Cascade, Crested Butte has something to offer for everyone.

THE LODGE

After the slopes, relax and unwind in the complimentary hot-tub or steam room.

Then, hop on the free shuttle to downtown Crested Butte, a small town with big flavor. You will find a variety of unique and locally owned boutiques, bars, restaurants and cafés. Reservations accepted until Dec. 24, 1:30 p.m.

THE RESORTS

Monarch Ski Area is one of the best local ski areas in the state with terrain for everyone. Situated in the middle of Colorado, it reaps the most snow from storms coming from every direction, so much it doesn't need to make snow like other resorts. With its short lift lines, good food and drinks, Monarch Mountain offers a very relaxed vibe.

Mount Princeton Hot Springs and Resort is one of the finest hot springs in Colorado. Soak in one of the many pools, and cascading pre-made basins, or build your own hot spring right in the middle of the river where the heat comes right out of the ground around you! With a snack bar and beverage service, as well as a spa, this resort is the perfect way to relax your muscles after skiing the previous day!

ALYESKA, AK

ALYESKA RESORT SKI TRIP IN ALASKA

Sat., Mar. 23 - Wed., Mar. 27 (USAFA Spring Break)

Cost: \$1600/person (may change depending on air fare). RecOn discount available.

Includes: Round Trip Flight - DIA to ANC (layover in Seattle); 4 nights lodging in the Alyeska Resort, double occupancy rooms; 3 days of ski lift tickets; all ground transportation to and from USAFA and Alyeska.

Does not include food, rental skis or baggage costs. USAFA rentals 50% off.

Heli Skiing is also available but not included in the price. It usually runs about \$1300 extra and includes a lot of skiing for the day. There are other opportunities available as well such as snowmobile trips and backcountry skiing.

THE RESORT

Alyeska Resort is truly a playground for all levels of skiers and riders. Offering 1,610 skiable acres, 76 named trails and over 669" of snow annually, Alyeska lives up to its reputation as steep and deep. Whether you are just starting out in the sport or looking to challenge yourself, you can find it here. Alyeska Resort hosts 7 total lifts which take you to a vertical rise of 2,500 ft: 2 high speed detachable quads, 2 fixed quads, 2 magic carpets and a 60-passenger Aerial Tram. Experts love the North Face, featuring North America's longest continuous double black run. Take a ride into the backcountry right from our private heli pad with Chugach Powder Guides. Intermediate and advanced skiers love the wide open bowls and long top-to-bottom runs. Tree-lined groomed runs are ideal for the beginner. Free-stylers can check out the features at either terrain park.
